

Using Class Charts for homework – Parent Guide

Year 7 will be our first year group to use a new feature of Class Charts — The homework module!

Students will be able to view homework set on the Class Charts App.


They will be able to

- See the tasks they need to do and when they are due;
- Collect any electronic documents that are needed for the homework;
- Mark work as completed and hand in, if needed.
- As parents or guardians, you will also be able to see homework set, when homework has been marked as completed and submitted.


Homework and the parent app


- If your account is linked to a student, you will be able to view most of the homework information the student can see.




The homework page looks like this






The page is divided into sections



In this context submitted means the work has been handed in to the teacher, either on Class Charts oy by another means.

When you click on a section it looks like this


Here you can see how many items of work are required to be completed




Here you can see the homework title, teacher, lesson and subject.

Here you can see the date the homework was set, when it is due and an estimate of how long the task should take.

How to view homework—step 1




How to view homework—step 2




This is the full view of the homework. If the student has marked the homework complete, it will say yes here.

When the teacher has marked the work as submitted (handed in) it will show here




Tools on the student app only

If the teacher gives feedback on Class Charts the student will see it marked here, this will not be visible on the parent app.




The feedback section will look like this



It is a little tricky to spot but the feedback is here


If the teacher attaches any documents with the feedback like an answer sheet you will see them here

How to mark homework as complete - Student app only



When a task is completed the student can click this box to mark it complete, then hand the work in to the teacher in the way they have requested. Work will not always be handed in on Class Charts, the teacher will tell the students how to hand in the work.


How to download a worksheet from a homework task



If the teacher has attached any documents to the homework task you will see them in the attachment section.

To download the worksheet, click on the document name and a copy will be saved to the downloads folder on your computer.

How to attach a worksheet to hand in for your homework – step 1




mov, m4a, sb3, py

If the teacher has asked the student to hand in work on Class Charts you will need to save the work to the computer first.

Then click on the orange upload attachment button to add the work.

Then the student can click complete to show then teacher your homework is complete
