
The Class Charts homework module!

You will be able to view your homework on the Class Charts App.


You will be able to


- See what you need to do and when it is due;




The homework page looks like this





The page is divided into sections




When you click on a section it looks like this



How to view your homework—step 1




How to mark homework as complete – step 2



When you have completed a piece of homework you can click this box to mark it complete, then hand the work in to your teacher in the way they have requested. You will not always have to hand work in on Class Charts, just mark it as complete, your teacher will tell you what to do.


How to download a worksheet from a homework task



If your teacher has attached any documents to your homework task you will see them in the attachment section.

To download the worksheet to your complete your task. Click on the document name and a copy will be saved to the downloads folder on your computer.

How to attach a worksheet to hand in for your homework – step 1




If your teacher has asked you to hand in your work on Class Charts you will need to save your work to your computer first.

Then click on the orange upload attachment button to add your work.

Then you can click complete to show your teacher your homework is complete


How to attach a worksheet to hand in for your homework – step 2




You can then mark as complete here

Your attached documents will show here


Completed tasks – show here




When your teacher has marked the work as submitted (handed in) it will show here
