


What is Youth Card?



DSC <u>Summer Schools</u> is a Dental Schools Council initiative in partnership with dental schools across England. The initiative is funded by NHS England.

The University of Leeds and the University of Sheffield are co-hosting an online summer school for Y11 students. The summer school has 80 places available and will take place on 25th-27th June 2024.

Participants will experience talks and workshops including mock clinical scenarios, learning about tooth morphology, common oral conditions and gain an insight into the roles and working lives of different members of the dental team. They will gain knowledge, skills and confidence to help them build a strong application to support their future ambitions.
