

NYBEP (North Yorkshire Business Education Partnership) are delighted to be working with Huntington School this year to offer a range of experiences for students in years 11 and 12.

These experiences are part of an exciting new programme called '**Your Adventure, Your Way**'. The programme is funded by the National Citizen Service (NCS) under the community branch of their offerings.

The programme consists of 3 experiences, where young people can pick and choose which elements they want to take part in, but we would love them to take part in all three!

Programme name:	Your Adventure, Your Way
Strapline:	Do it your way!
Structure:	<p>Three experiences:</p> <p>Life – one night residential where you get to create your own adventure! During your time with us you and your team will be given a budget and a range of activities to choose from so you can design your own experience.</p> <p>We will be heading to Canberra Farm, Doncaster on:</p> <p>7th & 8th October</p> <p>More dates to follow for 2024 (once it's warmer!)</p> <p>Skills – here we will be preparing you for your next steps and developing key skills to support your future pathway. This is all about making you shine! Young people will still take a lead on what they want to get out of 'skills', whether it's working on their CV and interview skills, learning more about University or Apprenticeships or looking at budgeting and money management. On this element there will also be a social enterprise activity.</p> <p>These workshops will take part in days in the school holidays. Local venues TBC.</p> <p>Action – putting all these skills into practice we will work with you to make a difference to something you care about. This experience will see the young people work together with their new friends on a social action project, or a couple of projects. Young people will decide on what project they want to do, but it is all about putting something back into the local community. They could organise a charity event, do some volunteering or even start a campaign.</p>

	This experience will be accessed in monthly meetings on an evening with local venues TBC.
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All the experiences offer something different but young people will:

- ✓ Meet new people.
- ✓ Opportunity to stay away from home for a night.
- ✓ Give back to their local community through voluntary action.
- ✓ Take on new challenges.
- ✓ Develop the skills and confidence to take on their next steps .
- ✓ Generate experience for their university application, job/apprenticeship interview or CV and more!
- ✓ Young people that take part in 2 of the experiences will gain a NCS certificate and those that do all three will be entered into a prize draw.

NCS is all about helping young people realise their potential by giving them a taste of independence and loading them up with new skills that set them up to achieve their future goals, whatever they may be. And this year, it's your young person's turn!

When your young person registers their interest in taking part in Your Adventure, Your Way, we will ask them to share your contact details. This is so that we can complete the administrative process required to get them signed up to a programme date. When they let us know they're interested, we'll be in touch with you by email or phone to run through the steps we need to complete their booking.

There is no cost for your teen takes part in Your Adventure, Your Way (including the residential), the only thing that you may have to provide is a packed lunch and transport (we will cover transport for the residential from a few pick-up points across the region).
