Entry requirements

To gain a place in the Sixth Form, **you will need three Grade 5s and two Grade 4s at GCSE**, including maths and English Language. The additional entry requirements for each subject are listed here for ease of reference, however, **please consult the detail of the subjects and their assessment, do not make a choice based on the information below.**

Art	5 GCSE Grades from 9 - 4, Grade 5+ in Art
Biology	6 in GCSE Combined Science OR a 6 in GCSE Biology. 6 in Maths & 5 English
Chemistry	6 in GCSE Combined Science OR a 6 in GCSE Chemistry. 6 in Maths & 5 in English
Computer Science	5 in GCSE Computer Science or ICT. Students will have to show their ability to programme and complete a computation task. 5 in Maths & English
Criminology	5 GCSE Grades from 9 – 4.
Digital Media	A range of GCSEs Grades 9-4, including ICT or Computer Science.
D&T: Product Design	5 GCSE's Grade 9-4. Grade 5 required in Design and Technology. Consideration given to students achieving Grade 5 in Art.
Drama	A range of GCSEs Grades 9-4. GCSE Drama not necessary
English Language (Sociolinguistics)	Grade 6 in English (in exceptional circumstances a 5 will be considered with the permission of the Subject Leader of English.)
English Literature	Grade 6 in English
Enterprise & Entrepreneurship	5 GCSE Grades from 9 - 4

Food Science and Nutrition	5 GCSE Grades from 9 – 4. A 9-4 GCSE Grade in Food Preparation and Nutrition is advantageous. Minimum Grade 5 in science.
French	5 GCSE Grades from 9 to 4. Incl. a Grade 6 in French.
Further Maths	Grade 7, but ideally an 8 or 9.
Geography	5 GCSE Grades from 9 – 4, including Geography, Maths and English at a Grade 5
German	5 GCSE Grades from 9 to 5. Incl. a Grade 6 in German.
Health and Social Care	5 GCSE Grades from 9-4 including a Grade 5 in Science and English. Previous knowledge of Health and Social Care is not required.
History	5 GCSE Grades from 9 – 4 in a range of subjects, including a Grade 5 in History and English. If students have not taken History GCSE, strong GCSE grades can
Mathematics	Grade 7 in GCSE mathematics.
Media Studies	5 GCSE Grades from 9 - 4 in a range of subjects, including a Grade 5 in English and a Grade 5 in another essay writing subject.
Medical Science	4-4 minimum in GCSE Combined Science (Trilogy) or a 4 in GCSE Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

Music	5 GCSE Grades from 9 – 4 . GCSE Grade 5 in Music. Equivalent of Music Grade V, on either a voice or instrument is highly recommended.
Music Technology	5 GCSE Grades from 9 – 4 in a range of subjects. No prior knowledge of Music Technology necessary. GCSE Music desirable but not essential.
Physical Education	5 GCSE Grades from 9 – 4 in a range of subjects, inc Grade 5 in English and science. GCSE PE not essential, but desirable. Currently competing or coaching at club standard outside of school.
Physics	6 in GCSE Combined Science OR a 6 in GCSE Physics. Grade 6 in Maths and Grade 5 in English.
Politics	5 GCSE Grades from 9 – 4 in a range of subjects, including a Grade 5 in English and a Grade 5 in another humanities/essay writing subject.
Psychology	5 GCSE Grades from 9 – 4 in a range of subjects, including a Grade 5 in English and a Grade 5 in another essay writing subject. Science and maths Grade 4 also needed.
Religious Studies	5 GCSE Grades from 9 – 4 in a range of subjects, including a Grade 5 in English and a Grade 5 in another essay writing subject.
Sociology	5 GCSE Grades from 9 – 4 in a range of subjects, including a Grade 5 in English and a Grade 5 in another essay writing subject.
Spanish	5 GCSE Grades from 9 to 5 including a minimum Grade 6 in Spanish.
Textiles	5 GCSE Grades from 9-4. Advantageous to have studied textiles or art, but not essential
