# Useful information

**Tutor group allocation and timetable** details will be confirmed on the 9<sup>th</sup> September.

We run a **1:1 devices policy in the Sixth Form**, which allows us to operate in a way that prepares ~ students for modern workplaces. Please see [the website](#) or scan this QR for more information.



More detail on the first day of Sixth Form:

**Arrive 8.30am on the 9<sup>th</sup> September and go to the Common Room** at the front of the Purple Block. The main school will line up on the tennis courts, but Year 12 will not – so ignore the overall flow of people!

Please **take note of the dress code** in the handbook.

The first two hours will be spent with your Tutor and tutor group, learning key info about the Sixth Form, familiarising yourself with systems and processes and exploring the site.

After a 15-minute **break**, Period 3 will be your **timetabled lesson**.

## **For lunch, students can:**

1. Go off site to get lunch locally.
2. Buy lunch in school using a **debit card** or via the cashless thumbprint system. Parents will need to use **Wisepay** to add funds to the students' account. Wisepay login details will be sent to parents on 7<sup>th</sup> September.

During period 4 (starting 13.10) we will have a **brief assembly** from the Sixth Form Team. With no Personal Development Programme running on the first day, the school day on the 9<sup>th</sup> September will finish at approximately 14.10. After this point, there will be chance for students to solve any issues with the Sixth Form Team. However, if you are planning to get picked up, most students **will be ready to leave at 14.10**.
